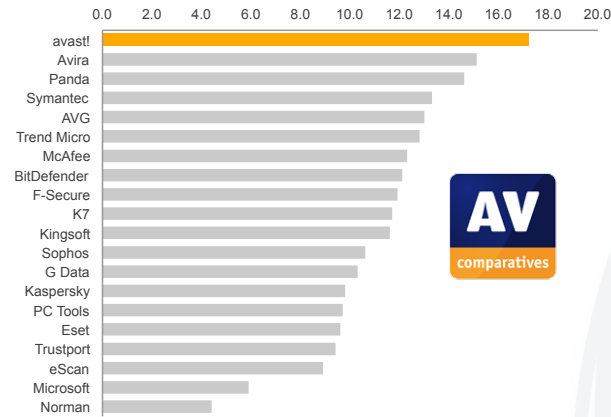

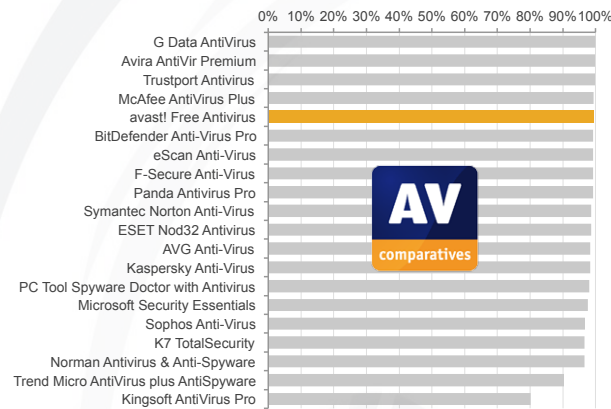

AV-Comparatives: On-Demand scanning speed [MB/s], Aug 2010

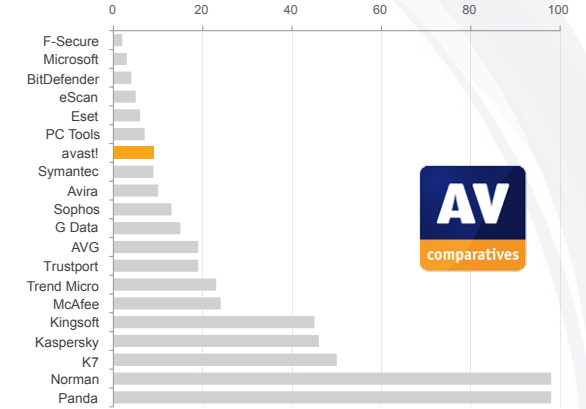
